Unfortunately, we had to withdraw our Under 18's from the competition due to lack of numbers. As you may know, we have a "blip" in our junior playing ranks for several years; last year affected the U16s and it has now graduated to our U18s. We had hoped to be able to field a team with some hard recruiting work, but events conspired against us and it was not possible.
