What is Gaelic Football

An Irish Team Sport play on all continents of the world

It is played between two teams on a rectangular grass pitch, with H-shaped goals at each end. Players advance the ball up the field with a combination of carrying, soloing (dropping & then toe-kicking the ball upward into the hands) kicking & hand-passing to their team-mates.

The objective of the sport is to score points by passing the ball through the other team's goals (3) points) or a set of two upright posts separated by a crossbar 2.5 metres (8.2 ft) above the ground (1 point).
