Following our recent discussion re various internal control and internal check measures, we set out below suggestions for same.

#### 1. Subscriptions

- (a) A full reconciliation should be completed at balance date.
- (b) Subscription register should provide a simple method of reconciliation at any time of the year.
- (c) It was mentioned that a future subscription account would be sent to members. This could simplify the system as a copy of the account might be used as a debtors ledger with unpaid account copies being kept on one file and paid accounts kept in another file.
- (d) In order to check the subscriptions in arrears situation at the end of the year, a policy re unfinancial members should be clarified after careful consideration of the constitution or any proposed amended constitution rule. In short, there is not enough control over subscriptions at present from an accounting point of view and consequently, this particular area is a problem for auditors.

#### 2. Functions

(a) Where a function is not a committee affair (say whilst auxiliary runs the morning tea etc.), results of function should be referred to committee who OK and accept net proceeds. In this event, auditors would not be interested in any other details.

(b) General club's functions should be controlled in a more organised fashion from a financial point of view. At the present time of course, it is easy to pay cash out from takings without having proper records of purchases, etc. Most clubs have a problem in this area but, notwithstanding this, some consideration should be given to the matter.

#### 3. Bar Transactions

- (a) We agree that sales should be divided into liquor, cigarettes, and food and sundries.
- (b) Bar percentages should be done regularly and in this regard, it is our suggestion that they be done once a month.
- (c) In the future it may be necessary to investigate the use of a multi register machine in the bar to control cash from various sources.
- (d) All purchases should be made on an official club order and the order carb note and invoice should be kept on file for inspection by the auditors.
- (e) No cash payment should be made from the till and all bankings should be made intact.

#### 4. Cash Book

- (a) Because of the foregoing, it may be necessary to revise headings in cash receipts and payments book.
- (b) If receipts are completely summarized at the point of banking, it will of course only be necessary to show the details in the cash receipts book.

#### 5. End-of-Year Preparation for Auditors

We now regard it as essential that we be supplied with the following schedules signed by the Secretary and one other committee member:

- A statement certifying the value of stock on hand at the end of the year.
- (ii) A list of trade creditors at the end of the year.



Although your letter of 1 April was directed to Syd Feldheim and marked "in confidence", Syd thought it sufficiently important to discuss with me and to be answered by the President of the Club.

We appreciate that your comments are made in the best interests of the club and admit that your criticism is quite justified. Our honorary secretaries over the years have tended to overlook the duty of expressing our appreciation for the support given by our members; I hope that we have not been guilty of this in the current year.

You enquired as to the rights and responsibilities of a Vice-President. These are not clearly defined in the Constitution except that a Vice-President is an Office Bearer and thus his rights exceed those of an ordinary member. He is not liable for an annual fee (so that you have no arrears, of course) but is entitled to full use of the clubhouse. Like all of us (including myself) he must pay an entrance fee to the ground to see games. It is a common practice for our Vice-Presidents to give a small donation in lieu of a membership fee but there is no obligation to do so.

We are unfortunately preoccupied with finance at present but we hope that our business affairs are now being straightened out so that we can concentrate more on rugby. The bar operation is our main source of income to repay our building loans but I agree whole-heartedly that this should not be allowed to alter the character of the Club.

It is not a pleasant duty to have to ask old members for financial assistance but we must admit that we are ambitious to build up Old Collegians and the game of rugby in South Australia. The main reason for our current Building Fund is to complete the lower part of the Clubhouse so that we can provide space for our junior players away from the bar area. This year we are actively coaching rugby in three colleges and Max Mitchell is coaching the State Schoolboys' Team. Next year we hope to have attracted sufficient youngsters to run junior teams in both rugby and cricket.

My committee, backed by a number of active members, is working hard and we hope that you will bear with us until the present difficulties are overcome. We are always pleased to hear from our older members and would be pleased to see you at games or in the Clubhouse at any time.






