

Finally to what is the main reason for this letter. Although, naturally, it was not unexpected, I must admit to a sense of loss with the impending retirement as President of Peter.

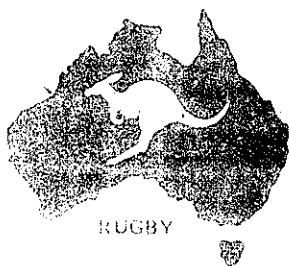
His achievements over the past 3 years particularly (bearing in mind his previous history of contributing) has been, I feel, the base upon which Old Coll's can build a substantial future.
