OC 52 v Mildura o

Finally, a strong run from Peter Cross fed Chris Steel on the very edge of the touchline for a sprint to the winning try after the buzzer. It was the game of the day!

We had a lighthearted warm up and a slow start which saw Souths get a strong early 17 – 5 lead, but we gained momentum and staged our comeback in time to match tries and win on conversions. Yay!
